II. Meeting Background

Artificial intelligence is increasingly becoming a key driving force in the higher education sector, prompting academia and industry to collectively face unprecedented opportunities and challenges. In September of this year, during the UNESCO Digital Learning Week, the "Guidance for generative AI in education and research" were officially released, providing guidelines and usage criteria for the widespread application of artificial intelligence. This milestone release signifies the global collaborative effort to comprehend and regulate the use of artificial intelligence in the field of education.

To guide the innovative use of artificial intelligence in the service of the common interests of humanity, empowering educators and learners to fully utilize the advantages of artificial intelligence in teaching and learning, the 2023 International Institute of Online Education (IIOE) Global Partners Summit has emerged. The summit aims to bring together global education leaders, policymakers, experts, scholars, industry professionals, and corporate entities to collectively explore the opportunities and challenges that artificial intelligence brings to higher education. The conference will delve into discussions on the impact of artificial intelligence on the governance and policies of higher education at the national and institutional levels, as well as the transformative changes in the professional development of educators amidst the challenges and advancements in artificial intelligence technology. Additionally, the summit will showcase best practices and innovative case studies from institutions and enterprises in different regions and conditions, highlighting the application of artificial intelligence in higher education.

The summit will officially release 'Higher Education in the Era of Artificial Intelligence White Paper'. This white paper will bring together the wisdom and recommendations of various stakeholders, providing forward-looking and actionable guidance to facilitate the orderly development of artificial intelligence in the field of higher education. Through active interaction, constructive dialogue, and extensive collaboration, participants from various sectors will contribute their professional insights, collectively building a sustainable future for the integration of artificial intelligence and higher education.
